Good afternoon,

If the firearm is permanently altered to a manually operated firearm it is considered legal, however our officers are not gunsmiths and if they observe what appears to be a semi-automatic firearm in the field be prepared to demonstrate and prove that it has been permanently altered to their satisfaction. If a "Kali-Key" is installed, and the word Kali-Key is embossed on the top of the Kali-Key charging handle for the warden to see, then the firearm will be deemed lawful.
